

LOCATION

Situated to the north of the village of The Lee within easy reach of Wendover, Great Missenden, Chesham and Amersham which are all with 7 miles. London (Marble Arch) is 36 miles. All distances are approximate.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in the Chilterns Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the woodlands enjoy a special location. The village of The Lee, well known due to its appearances in Midsomer Murders, is to the south. The woods are also in the Greenbelt and Chilterns Beechwood Special Area of Conservation. They are particularly beautiful in the spring with large areas carpeted with bluebells.

The Lots comprise:-

LOT 1: CONCORD WOOD 140.55 acres / 56.88 hectares Guide price: £700,000

Concord Wood enjoys excellent access over Timberley Lane on its southern boundary. This stoned track then runs into and west through most of the wood, linking with a series of internal rides. This access has been used for all purposes including timber extraction.

The woodland has a long history of management and this is evidenced in the quality of the crops, particularly in the mid rotation beech and oak. Excluding Barn Wood, which is let to the Forestry Commission, the balance of the wood totals about 48 hectares. Around 45 percent of the crops are mixed broadleaves planted between 1930 and 1947. The principal species are beech and oak with cherry, sycamore, ash, lime and hornbeam also present. A small stand of 1930s Corsican pine and Norway spruce is present.

Since 1971 the age structure has been varied by the felling of coupes and restocking, principally with broadleaves but also including conifers. The most recent restocking in the centre of the wood took place in the spring of 2019. The focus was on conifers with a species mix of 60% Douglas fir, 20% red cedar, 10% Lawson cypress and 10% Japanese cedar. Planting was in tubes and the crop is growing well. Some natural regeneration of sycamore is being accepted into the stocking.

A stocking schedule and plan is available from the Selling Agents upon request.

21.9 acres, known as Barn Wood and shown hatched on the sale plan, is let to the Forestry Commission on a 999 year lease which commenced in 1966. The annual rent payable is ± 2.75 which is fixed for the period of the lease. A copy of the lease is available upon request from the Selling Agents.

Grim's Ditch, a Scheduled Ancient Monument, runs through Concord Wood.

Access is over a hard track marked ABC on the sale plan.

LOT 2: LORDLING WOOD 28.44 acres / 11.51 hectares Guide price: £225.000

This is a delightful mixed age, small Chilterns woodland containing principally beech and oak. Other species are present including birch, sycamore and ash. Access to the wood is good via Timberley Lane on the north western boundary and Furze Field Lane/Swan Lane on the southern boundary.

Access is over a hard track marked AB on the sale plan or off Swan Lane/Furze Field Lane at point D on the sale plan.

The gate on Timberley Lane to the west of point A is locked. Please contact the Selling Agents for the gate code.


METHOD OF SALE


